NO CHEQUES WILL BE ACCEPTED AS PAYMENT WITHOUT SUCH REFERENCES. In the event of any noncompliance by a buyer with or under this Condition the lot or lots purchased may be put up again and resold whereupon if the highest bid price upon such a resale is less than that originally payable by the buyer he shall be liable to pay the difference to the Auctioneers. Then Auctioneers shall have absolute discretion in all matters required by or pursuant to this Condition.

- 9. All lots are sold as shown, with all faults, imperfections and errors of description and neither the Auctioneers nor any seller are responsible for errors of description or for genuineness or authenticity of any lot, or for any faults or defects therein, howsoever caused. No warranties or representations whatever are intended to be, or are to be taken as made or given to any buyer by the Auctioneers or ant seller in respect of any lot, nor has any person in the employ of the Auctioneers any authority to make or give any warranty or representation whatever in respect of any lot, and any implied conditions, warranties or representations, statutory or otherwise. (with the exception of those implied under Section 12 of the Sale of Goods Act 1893 as amended) are hereby excluded.
- 10. The property in a lot purchased shall not pass to the buyer until he/she has paid the total price in full to the Auctioneers, nevertheless any lot purchased shall be at the sole risk of the buyer from the fall of the hammer.
